## 100 Club Rules r2

- All enquiries should be addressed to the Secretary of Woking Strokeability details below.
- There is no restriction on ownership of numbers.
- Email will be used for all communications.
- All numbers must be purchased by an adult with a contact email address. These individuals
  will be the members of the 100 Club and added to the club email circulation list
- Numbers can be purchased on behalf of others.
- A list will be held of all individuals purchasing numbers and the beneficiaries
- Numbers will be offered for sale at the start of run and in the first instance offered to a current purchaser. Each run will last for 6 months.
- Numbers from 1 to 100 will be available for purchase by named individuals. More than one number can be purchased by any individual.
- Numbers will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The request for any number should be made by email and will be confirmed by email.
- The club will have a draw of one winning number each month during each run. Each number can only win once in every 6 month run.
- Each number purchased at the start will be entered into 6 monthly draws at a cost of £5
  each month, purchased in advance for £30 paid to the Treasurer, preferably by bank
  transfer.
  - o Any unpaid numbers will removed from the draw and revert to being unsold.
  - Unsold numbers can be bought at any time at £5 for each remaining month.
- The winning number each month will normally be drawn at the last members meeting of the month at the gym and will receive 40% of the amount raised that month. The prize will normally be paid by bank transfer.
- After every draw an email will be sent to all members of both the 100 Club and Woking Strokeability lists with the number drawn and name of the winner.
- A copy of the Rules shall be available to everyone purchasing a number.
- Woking Strokeability Trustees may their discretion change the parameters of a run at the
  outset to allow more than 100 numbers to be made available, change the length of a run
  and cost of each number etc.
- Any matter requiring adjudication shall be determined by the Trustees of Woking Strokeability whose decision on all matters regarding the administration of the 100 Club shall be final.
